Extra credit assignments will not count a specific number of points towards your total grade, *unless otherwise specified*. The primary goal of such extra assignments is to help the course instructors to decide on borderline cases. For example, suppose your final grade corresponds to a B+, but it is sufficiently close to the cutoff for an A-. In such a case, having done all or most of the extra credit problems may lead the instructors to decide that you deserve a little boost in your grade, giving you an A-.
